

ANDERSON COUNTY DEVELOPMENT CORPORATION

The Anderson County Development Corporation was incorporated in October of 1997 to enhance, promote and stimulate economic and community development within Anderson County, including all political subdivisions located therein. The property, affairs and business of the Corporation are managed by a board of directors composed of nine (9) members, including the County Executive of Anderson County, the Mayors of Oak Ridge and Clinton, the chairpersons of the Oak Ridge Chamber of Commerce and the Anderson County Economic Development Association, four citizens or residents of Anderson County, two appointees of the Anderson County Commission, and two appointees of the Mayor of Oak Ridge subject to the approval of the Oak Ridge City Council.

The Corporation also has an Operating Committee composed of seven (7) members including two designees (the Presidents of the Oak Ridge Chamber of Commerce and Anderson County Economic Development Association) and five appointees, three of whom shall be executives of Anderson County's commercial banking and financial institution community and two of whom shall have industrial and/or commercial development experience. Of the five appointees, two are selected by the Anderson County Executive, two by the Mayor of Oak Ridge, and one by the Mayor of Clinton.
