<b>SESSION VI</b> JULY 14 - 18	<b>TUESDAY, JULY 15 - TENNESSEE AQUARIUM</b> - Chattanooga - Be at the Civic Center by <u>7:45 AM</u> this morning to leave for the aquarium by <u>8:00 AM</u> . Tour both aquariums and see a 3-D movie at the IMAX Theater. Return to Civic Center no later than <u>5:00 PM</u> .		<b>FRIDAY, JULY 18- TRI-COUNTY ROLL ARENA</b> - Skate, rattle and roll from 9:30 AM to 11:30 AM. We will return to the Civic Center by noon for lunch. Also, don't forget to bring your swimsuit for the outdoor pool in the afternoon.

We will have snow cones to cool us off!		<b>FRIDAY, AUGUST 1 -ZUMA FUN CENTER</b> - Knoxville - Leave at 9:30 AM and return at 4:00 PM. Have lots of fun with games and rides. Armbands, tokens, and a pizza lunch are provided.	

- Campers should arrive at camp by 8:45 AM on field trip mornings. Buses are scheduled to leave as soon after 9 AM roll call as possible. The Tennessee Aquarium field trip is an exception. Because of the trip distance, children need to be at the Civic Center by 7:45 AM and ready to leave at 8:00 AM.
- If parent(s) would like to attend field trips with their child, they must provide their own transportation and admission fees.
- All campers should wear camp T-shirts on field trip days.
- Extra money is needed only if a camper wants to purchase souvenirs, extra food, or drinks.
- School buses and/or City of Oak Ridge vehicles will be used for transportation.
- Campers should come prepared to swim every day. Campers sometimes have the opportunity to swim after half-day field trips.
- Tennis shoes and socks are required for all camp activities and trips except when campers are in the pool area.
